- The Ministry of Blue Economy, Marine Resources, Fisheries and Shipping is inviting companies and individuals engaged in fishing activities who wish to benefit from the above scheme to submit their applications for a grant to purchase a semi-industrial fishing vessel.
- Successful applicants will be eligible to a one-off grant of Rs. 1M to meet the cost of a new or second-hand semi-industrial fishing vessel of less than 5 years old acquired during the Financial Year 2024/25.

Semi-Industrial Fishing Boat Grant Scheme - Grant to Companies and Individuals

Additional Information

1. Semi-Industrial Grant Scheme

This scheme provides for a grant of Rs.1 million to companies and individuals engaged in fishing activities for the purchase of a semi-industrial fishing vessel for off-lagoon and bank fishing.

2. Who is Eligible

Under this scheme, companies and individuals engaged in fishing activities will be eligible for a grant to purchase a new or second hand semi-industrial fishing vessel to fish in the outer lagoon and on the banks.

The scheme is open to fishing companies or individuals registered under the Small and Medium Enterprises Act as follows:

- (i) microenterprise (i.e. annual turnover not exceeding Rs.10 million); or
- (ii) small enterprise (i.e. annual turnover exceeding Rs.10 million but not exceeding Rs.30 million).

3. Who is not eligible

Fishing companies or individuals that have already benefited from a grant under this scheme are not eligible.

4. Type of Semi-Industrial Fishing Vessel

The semi-industrial fishing vessel should be above <u>12 metres but less than 24 metres</u> in length overall and should be fitted with inboard engine and all the navigation, communication, safety and appropriate fishing equipment. In the event of a second-hand fishing vessel is to be acquired, it should not be more than 5 years old and with an economic lifetime of a minimum of 15 years.

The grant shall be used exclusively towards financing of semi-industrial fishing vessel.

5. How to benefit from the Scheme

Interested companies and individuals engaged in fishing activities are required to submit their applications together with all relevant documents in a sealed envelope to the Acting Senior Chief Executive, Ministry of Blue Economy, Marine Resources, Fisheries and Shipping, Level 4, LIC Building, President John Kennedy Street, Port Louis or be deposited in the nearest Fisheries Post.

The sealed envelope should be clearly marked 'Application for Grant under the Semiindustrial fishing vessel grant scheme – Companies and Individuals'.

The Application Form and Project Guidelines can either be collected from all Fisheries Posts around the island or downloaded from the website of the Ministry (https://blueconomy.govmu.org/Pages/Downloads/Downloads.aspx).

6. Processing of Applications

A Selection Committee set up by the Ministry of Blue Economy, Marine Resources, Fisheries and Shipping shall verify all the applications received to ascertain whether the applicant is eligible for a grant under the scheme. In this respect, the applicant may be required to furnish additional information/documents as may be required by the Selection Committee for a proper assessment of the applications.

On approval of the application, the Ministry of Blue Economy, Marine Resources, Fisheries and Shipping shall authorise the applicant to proceed with the acquisition of the semi-industrial fishing vessel and its registration with the Ministry.

Note: Companies and individuals who have already acquired a semi-industrial fishing vessel during this Financial Year, that is, from 01 July 2024 to date, may also submit an application for a grant to this Ministry. The semi-industrial fishing vessel should be registered with the Ministry of Blue Economy, Marine Resources, Fisheries and Shipping for fishing in the outer lagoons and on the banks.

In case the vessel is to be acquired, the Ministry will issue a Letter of Intent to successful applicants to allow them to proceed with the acquisition of the vessel.

7. Disbursement of Grant

The beneficiary shall inform the Acting Senior Chief Executive when the semi-industrial fishing vessel has been acquired and registered with the Ministry.

The semi-industrial fishing vessel shall be examined by a registered Marine Surveyor to ascertain compliance with the criteria set by the Ministry.

The Acting Senior Chief Executive will arrange for the disbursement of the grant to the beneficiary subject to such terms and conditions as deemed appropriate.

The one-off grant of Rs.1 million shall be made on a refund basis to eligible individuals or microenterprises/small enterprises upon submission of documentary evidence of the semi-industrial fishing vessel acquired.

The beneficiary shall not dispose of or lease the semi-industrial fishing vessel, in respect of which a grant has been disbursed, during a period of at least 10 years as from the date of the disbursement of the grant.

The beneficiary will be required to sign a Letter of Undertaking with the Ministry prior to disbursement of funds.

Requirements for Equipment for Fishing Vessels of more than 12 Metres but less than 24 Metres in length

For each vessel:

- 1. Enough life rafts to accommodate all PERSONS the vessel is permitted to carry on board and fitted with Hydrostatic Release Unit (s). Life raft(s) to be serviced annually. HRUs to be replaced when expired. Life raft to be equipped as per SOLAS.
- 2. At least 2 lifebuoys fitted with buoyant line of 30 metres each.
 - At least one of the lifebuoys to be fitted with a self-Igniting light.
 - Life buoys to be fitted with retro-reflective tape.
- 3. Pyrotechnics: (a) Rocket Parachute Flares; and (b) Hand Flares
- 4. At least one lifejacket (SOLAS & fitted with light) for each person on board and 2 spares.
- 5. Enough and appropriate fire extinguishers as determined by surveyor, but in any case, not less than four (Aqueous foaming 2x9lt, CO2 2x5kg). Extinguishers to be serviced regularly.
- 6. Electric Fire alarm which may be used as General Emergency Alarm.
- 7. Fire Hydrants/Fire Nozzles/Fire Hoses as appropriate.
- 8. At least 1 Fireman's Axe.
- 9. Radar reflector of suitable size.
- 10. Navigation Equipment
 - (a) Magnetic compass is to be in a waterproof marine binnacle. Compass awing is to be carried out for the compass at intervals determined by the marine surveyor and a deviation card is to be placed in a waterproof casing alongside it available for ready reference;

(b) Radar (at least one);
(c) Echo Sounding Device (one set);
(d) At least one GPS;
(e) Navigation charts for area vessel intends to navigate;
(f) Parallel Ruler/Set Squares, Pencils;
(g) Dividers 1 set;
(h) One Barometer;

- (i) Lights as per Collision Regulations; and
- (j) Daylight signaling equipment for visual distress signaling as per international conventions.
- 11. Communication Equipment
 - (a) HF/SSB Radio (one x 500 watts) with DSC facility;
 - (b) Standard MMB VHF set (25 watts);
 - (c.) EPIRB (one) with inbuilt GPS and fitted with HRU;
 - (d) SART (one);
 - (e) Navtex Receiver (one);
 - (f) One portable VHF GMDSS compatible with Channel 16;
 - (g) One Satellite Phone; and
 - (h) VMS and AIS (Class B).
- 12. Vessel to be fitted with anchor and associated equipment.
