

Government Notice No.54 of 2006

THE FISHERIES AND MARINE RESOURCES ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 9(1) and 73 of the Fisheries and Marine Resources Act 1998

1. These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries and Marine Resources (undersized Fish) Regulations 2006.
2. In these regulations -
“Act” means the Fisheries and Marine Resources Act.
3. For the purpose of section 2 of the Act, fish of the species and size specified in the Schedule shall be undersized fish.
4. The Fisheries Regulations 1983 are amended by revoking regulation 7 and the Fifth Schedule.

1. Length measured from the tip of the snout up to the tip of tail fin.
2. Length measured from the base of the eye-stalk to the end of the thorax ("carapace" length).
3. Length measured between lateral spines found on both sides of the shell ("carapace" width).
4. Length measured from the tip of the umbo to the furthest point of the shell margin.
5. Length measured from the tip of mantle to the level of the eye (mantle length).
