Fisheries Hotline – 800 1011

The Fisheries Protection Service (FPS) wishes to inform the general public, fishers and other stakeholders that **800 1011** is the central Fisheries Hotline operated from the **Mahebourg Fisheries Post**.

The hotline provides a direct channel for reporting **suspected illegal fishing activities, fisheries-related offences and other matters falling within the jurisdiction of the Fisheries Protection Service**.

Members of the public are encouraged to report

Members of the public, fishers and other stakeholders are encouraged to promptly report any **suspected illegal fishing activity, fisheries-related offence or other matter requiring the attention of the Fisheries Protection Service** by calling:

When making a report, callers are encouraged to provide **accurate and relevant information**, including the location, nature of the activity, time of occurrence and any other details that may assist officers in taking appropriate action.
