

**IMPORTANT:**

- 1) Application must be made on original form obtained from Fisheries Post in both Mauritius and Rodrigues, Office of the Fishermen Welfare Fund and the Rodrigues Regional Assembly.
- 2) Incomplete, inaccurate, inadequate filling of the form or non-submission of documents requested for may lead to disqualification.
- 3) Submission of filled application form after the closing date will not be accepted.
- 4) For Post HSC, in case any qualification submitted requires recognition or equivalence from the relevant authorities (Tertiary Education Commission of Mauritius Qualifications Authority) your attention is drawn that the onus for the submission of the same rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered failing the non-submission of Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, **by the closing date.**
- 5) Application must be supported by the following documents:-
  - i) Examination Result slips and/or copies of all Certificates obtained;
  - ii) Birth Certificate of student;
  - iii) Fisherman Card (Both recto & verso part showing the latest stamp);
  - iv) **Original** attestation from school/college/institution presently attended by the applicant;

  - vi) Copy of National Identity Card of Fisher;
  - vii) Copy of National Identity Card of Guardian.
- 6) Duration of Scholarship (a) Post PSAC – Grade 7, 8, 9 – 3 years.
  - (b) Post PSAC – Extended Stream – 4 years.
  - (c) Post SC – Grade 12 & 13 – 2 years.
  - (d) Post HSC – University Studies – up to 4 years.
  - (e) Vocational – NC 2 and/or 3 or equivalent - Duration of Course.
  - (f) Vocational or Polytechnic - NC 4 and/or 5 or equivalent – Duration of Course.
  - (g) Vocational or Polytechnic – NC 6 and/or onwards or equivalent – Duration of Course.
  - (h) Post Graduation Course – Up to 2 years.
- 7) Applicable **only** for Post HSC:- Any student cannot hold more than one scholarship award or benefit from any other financial assistance concurrently, excluding Cash Prize. In case the student obtains another offer of Award, s/he will have to forfeit one of the Awards and inform the Fishermen Welfare Fund in writing immediately failing which s/he may have to forfeit the Awards.
