FISHERIES AND MARINE RESOURCES ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 74 of the Fisheries and Marine Resources Act 2007

- **1.** These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries and Marine Resources (Fishing of Sea Cucumbers) Regulations 2008.
- 2. In these regulations –

"sea cucumber" means a fish belonging to the holothuroid class;

"undersized sea cucumber" means any sea cucumber which is less than 15 centimetres in length.

- **3.** Subject to regulation 4, the Permanent Secretary may authorise the fishing of sea cucumbers under such terms and conditions as he thinks fit.
- **4.** No person shall fish
 - (a) any undersized sea cucumber; or
 - (b) any sea cucumber from 1 January to 31 March in a year.
- **5.** No person shall land, have in his possession or sell any undersized sea cucumber.
- **6.** These regulations shall come into operation on 15 September 2008.
